6:30-8:30am - On-site Registration for all events – Dirt Lot behind Home Depot **Directions:** From College Dr./Main Ave. go west, in .25 miles turn left at light onto Camino Del Rio/HWY 550 South, proceed 3.5 miles, turn right onto River Rd. and right into parking lot.

8am – Morehart Murphy La Posta Team Time Trial – ITT for USAC Categories

Course- A 21K course that starts just across the bridge from Home Depot on CR 213, has some small rollers but loses 400 ft in elevation to the finish at the end at HWY550S. It is a point-to-point course so be prepared with a vehicle to drive clothes down to finish or for pickup. Centerline rule in effect.
